Better, Best Online print labs

Looking for a great online print lab? We test three services that deliver prints from your uploaded files direct to your doormat

After hours tinkering away in Photoshop to create some of your best work - whether photographic or illustrative creating a tactile print can be the most rewarding way of viewing the fruits of your labour.

Although home printers have come a long way over recent years, ink costs remain high, and using a third-party print lab to print your files is a sure way of getting great quality prints with none of the home-based ink and paper hassle. Online labs are easy to use, cost-effective, and they offer a variety of paper types and print sizes - right up to scales beyond what a standard home printer could achieve. Plus, the prints are delivered directly to your home, of course.

Although the word 'lab' may sound a bit daunting to some, you needn't feel intimidated. The three we've tested in this issue all have an easy-to-use online submission process: You sign up to the service and upload your files using a web browser, where images can be stored in online galleries to reuse at a later date should you choose to reprint.

Many online photo lab companies also offer print mounting, book printing and a variety of other services that are difficult or not feasible to replicate at home.

Whatever you want to do with your files, you'll find the printing process is a simple case of clicking the right boxes.

But which company is right for your needs? What are the differences in service, print options and final quality? Read our roundup to find out...

The turnaround time was fast in our test, and the prints we got looked decent. The packaging was also sturdy and foil-wrapped to protect th pictures from the element during transit.

A 10MB file size limit for u is limiting, particularly as lossless formats and larger are essential for some wor.


VALUE VERDICT

Postage and packing is also cheaper than its competitors, which means small orders are all the more affordable. Like Photobox, Jessops also offers a range of

photo-printing options, such as calendars, mugs, and so on.

WELIKE ...

The online gallery makes for easy access to your files, plus a simple 'quality-checker' ensures that prints will look as good as they should.

WE'D LIKE ...

More paper choices. There's only a 'high quality gloss finish' with or without borders - we'd like to see lustre and matte finishes, too.

VALUE VERDICT

The Jessops service is a good all-rounder in terms of cost, overall quality and the ability to handle multiple file types.
